

Exporting PDF from Quark 6

You will have to create your own settings to export PDF from Quark. Use the instructions below and on the next page.

About crop marks...

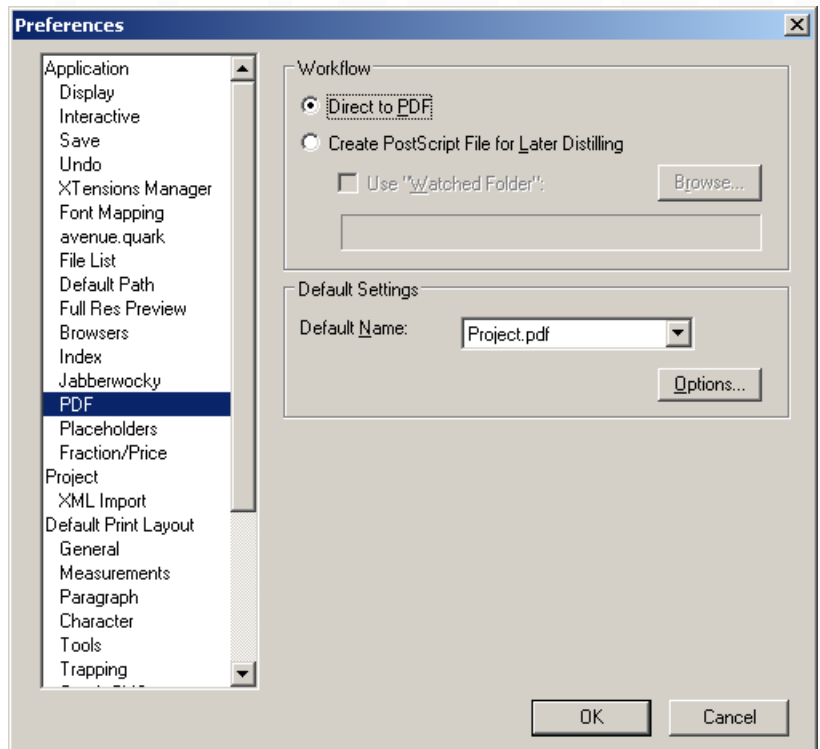
Please do not include them on text files. Our imposition software adds the crop marks where they are needed. However, if your document will bleed, make sure you set the original document to bleed 1/8" all around. The PDF settings from OPI will take that into account and give you the correct sheet size, e.g. a 6" x 9" will become 6.25" x 9.25"

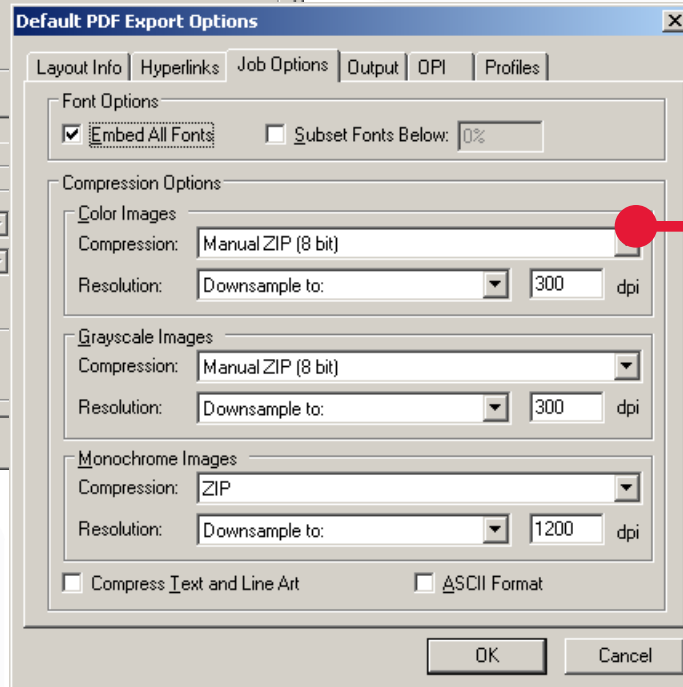
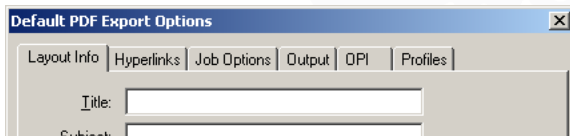
If the file you are sending is a cover (see the document *Creating a Cover Spread.pdf*), please set the bleed to 1/2" all around (your actual bleeds only have to extend 1/8") so you can add spine marks. Then make sure you check "Crop Marks" under "Marks and Bleeds" when you export the PDF so you will get the cover trim marks as well.

Step 1: Edit/Preferences/PDF...

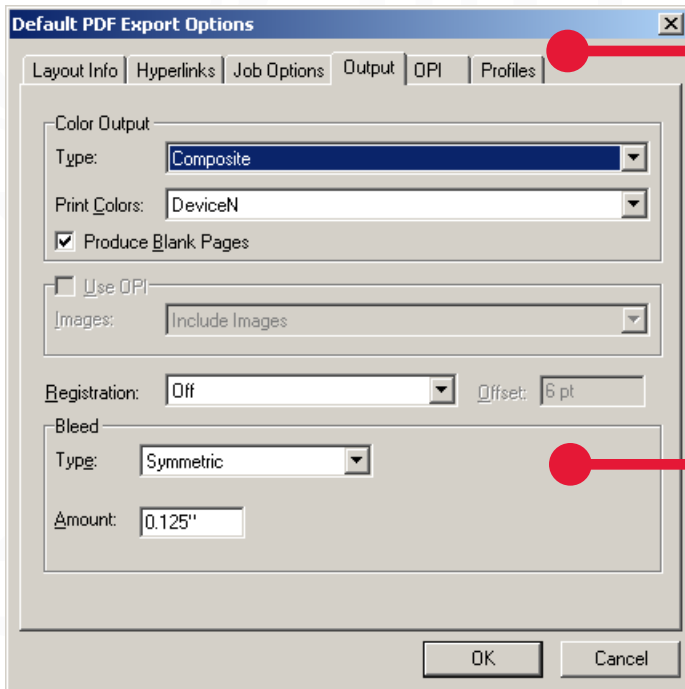
Step 2: Choose "Direct to PDF" and then click on the "Options" button.

Step 3: Set the preferences in each tab using the screen shots on the following page.





Completely embed your fonts, the setting we prefer.



Device N will give you the best overall color results. Spot colors stay tagged as spot and color applied to grayscale tiffs renders correctly.

Registration should be off unless your file is a cover spread.
